



Parthia: The Forgotten Ancient Superpower and its Role in Biblical History




This book details the history of the greatest Israelite empire in the post-exilic period. This ancient superpower rival of Rome that lasted for half a millennium was the Parthian Empire. Parthia and Rome fought battles that were among the largest and most pivotal ever fought in the ancient world. Even Roman writers acknowledged that it was the equal of the Roman Empire. In fact, its forces frequently defeated Roman armies in many wars, and Parthia was the only empire that Rome actually feared. Just decades before the birth of Christ, its armies drove the Romans completely out of Palestine, Syria and Asia Minor, forcing the reigning King Herod to flee for his life. Its Semitic-Israelite origins are well documented as well as the fact that its single dynasty was descended from King David. Another surprise: the cover of the book shows a cutaway diagram of an ancient Parthian direct current battery. A number of these batteries have been found, and this book documents the sensational discovery of electricity and examines its possible ancient uses.

Parthia rose to power as Carthage fell, and the names of Israelite tribes and clans are in evidence within the Parthian Empire. Parthia's first capital city was named after "Isaac." Josephus, the famous Jewish historian, records that the ten tribes were a very numerous people in Asia and he identifies them as living in Parthia's empire. Secular histories have long acknowledged that the Parthians were related to the Scythian tribes, and Scythian "Sacae" tribes often assisted the Parthians in their wars against Greece and Rome. Some of the events

of Jesus' life become more understandable when they are examined in light of the politics that prevailed between Rome and Parthia at that time. One group of the Parthian elites that chose Parthia's emperors was called the "Magi" or "Wise Men." A delegation of these high Parthian officials worshiped the young Jesus!

Israel's Tribes Today

Most efforts to locate the "lost" House of Israel have failed because of erroneous assumptions. Searchers assume that the supposedly "lost" ten tribes of Israel would be found in isolated little bands of people. However, the first chapter of Hosea and other biblical prophecies foretold that the nations of the ten tribes would be found among the wealthy and powerful nations with large populations! This book identifies the modern House of Israel as those nations descending from the Goths, Saxons, Germans and related peoples who migrated into Europe from Asia after the fall of Parthia and Scythia. They have enjoyed national prominence, power and prosperity as the primary recipients of the divine "birthright" blessings of the Abrahamic Covenant. Many other nations also have Israelite roots, in whole or in part. Not only did they retain Semitic-Israelite names and customs, but many of the tribal and clan names of the ten tribes of Israel are found among them. This book presents new research and illustrations to provide convincing evidence about the Israelite origin of large modern nations. The final portion of this book utilizes Biblical prophecies about the tribes of Israel, as well as evidence from secular history, to identify the descendants of each tribe in the modern world.
